Campaign to Abolish the Eighth Amendment

Campaigners for the repeal of the Eighth Amendment believe that abortion is necessary in order to avoid the risk to women's lives posed by some medical conditions during pregnancy. Let's be clear that the Church has never taught that the life of a child in the womb should be preferred to that of a mother. Where a seriously ill pregnant woman needs medical treatment which may put the life of her baby at risk, such treatments are always ethically permissible, provided every effort has been made to save the life of both the mother and her baby.

A Human Rights Issue

We can be sure that in the debates and media coverage that will precede the referendum those who oppose the taking of human life in the womb at all stages will be portrayed as extremists, absolutists and religious fanatics. But don't be intimidated. This is not just a Church issue. In fact it is not primarily a religious issue at all. It's an ethical issue and a human rights issue. Every human being has an equal right to life. It is not an extreme position to recognise that right and to defend it. -----Bishop Leo O Reilly
